It is located approximately southeast of Hinton, Alberta, and is one of several craters associated with a northeast-trending fault system that stretches from the northwest boundary of Athabasca oil sands deposits to the Liard River. This fault system runs into the Fort McMurray region and is called the McMurray-Hinton seismic zone. This is a collapsed impact crater, formed by impact with an unknown body about 4.4 million years ago. The crater was excavated by meltwater as the impactor was traveling towards the west. All that remains of the crater today are three hills, a ghost town, a pumping station and a pumping well. The site is accessible via Highway 33, approximately south of Hinton.
